Voting Guidelines

- Effective November 19, 2020, through December 17, 2020, a voter may vote for any eligible nonprofit agency (as defined below) of his/her choosing every 24 hours at www.oldnational.com/cyc.
- The voting will be limited to one per day based on the voter's provided email address.
- Voting closes at 11:59 p.m. CST on December 17, 2020.
- Voter must enter a valid email address on the website voting platform to vote.
- No purchase necessary.
- Old National associates are not eligible to vote.
- Void where prohibited.

Awards Guidelines

- Each eligible nonprofit agency in the Old National Bank's Minnesota service area has been assigned to one of the 31 Old National Banking Centers based on the agency's zip code. Visit www.oldnational.com/locations to see Old National's Banking Centers in the state of Minnesota. A nonprofit cannot be assigned to more than one Banking Center.
- At the conclusion of the four-week voting period, the top vote getter at each of the 31 Banking Centers will receive a \$5,000 donation from Old National.
- At the conclusion of the four-week voting period, the nonprofit that receives the most votes among all 31 Banking Centers will receive an additional \$10,000 donation from Old National for a total of \$15,000 to the highest overall vote getter.
- The winning nonprofit agencies may be asked to participate in media promotion or photo opportunities with Old National Bank.

Eligible Nonprofits

This list of Minnesota-based nonprofit agencies included in Choose Your Charity was pulled from the [IRS](https://www.irs.gov). Organizations eligible are registered as a 501(c)(3) with the IRS within our 16-county footprint and must be less than 25 miles away from the nearest Old National Banking Center. - The nonprofit name must be the official name of the 501(c)(3) organization to be eligible; not an individual.
- If part of a national organization, the nonprofit should be listed as the local affiliate.
- Nonprofits that do not have a presence in the market, as determined by Old National, are not eligible.
- Certain organizations may be excluded at the discretion of Old National Bank.
